Determine the Weight and Size

UPS ExpressSM Freight

How to determine billable weight

Compare the freight shipment's minimum billable weight, actual weight and dimensional weight. The greater of the three is the billable weight and should be used to calculate the rate.

1. Minimum billable weight of a freight shipment is 151 lbs.
2. Determine actual weight and round up any fraction of a pound to the next full pound.
3. Determine dimensional weight by multiplying the item's length by the width by the height. For each dimension, measure the largest distance, rounding each measurement to the nearest whole number. The result is the cubic size. Divide the cubic size by 166 when measured in inches. To convert metric measurements into pounds, multiply the result by 2.20462. Increase any fraction to the next pound.

*Pallet billable weight is equal to the shipment weight (315 lbs.) plus the weight of a pallet (approximately 40 lbs.). Note: Each pallet and its secured contents is entered as one piece.

How to Determine the Rate

UPS ExpressSM Freight

To determine the rate for UPS Express Freight:

1. Compute the billable weight (refer to page 1).
2. Look up the shipping zone (refer to page 3).
3. Calculate the rate:
 - Use UPS WorldShipTM or the "Calculate Time and Cost" application on ups.com[®] to see the rate for your shipment.*

Or

- Follow the steps below to use the rate chart on page 4.
 1. Go to the rate chart on page 4.
 2. Match the billable weight to the appropriate zone. Any fraction of a pound more than the weight shown in the rate chart is rounded up to the next whole pound
 3. Additional charges may apply, including but not limited to, special options or value-added services. Contact your local UPS Supply Chain Solutions[®] service center for details (see ups-scs.service.com/directory for specific telephone numbers).
