Determine the Weight and Size

UPS Express® Freight

How to Determine Billable Weight

Compare the freight shipment's minimum billable weight, actual weight and dimensional weight. The greater of the three is the billable weight and should be used to calculate the rate.

Step 1

Minimum billable weight of a freight shipment

is 71 kg.

Step 2

Determine actual weight and round up any fraction of a kilogram to the next half (0.5) kilogram.

Step 3

Determine dimensional weight

by multiplying the item's length by the width by the height.

For each dimension, measure the largest distance, rounding each measurement to the nearest whole number. The result is the cubic size. Divide the cubic size by 5,000 when measured in centimetres.

Round up

any fraction of a kilogram to the next half (0.5) kilogram.

Freight Billable Weight: Using a Pallet*

| No. of Pieces | Type | Length Each | Width Each | Height Each | Shipment Weight | Pallet Weight | Min. Billable Weight | Actual Weight | Dim. Weight | Billable Weight |
|---------------|--------|-------------|------------|-------------|-----------------|---------------|----------------------|---------------|---------------|-----------------|
| 1 | Pallet | 102 cm | 122 cm | 77 cm | 143 kg | 19 kg | 71 kg | 162 kg | 192 kg | 192 kg |

* Pallet billable weight is equal to the shipment weight (143 kg) plus the weight of a pallet (approximately 19 kg). Each pallet and its secured contents is entered as one piece.

Determine the Rates

UPS Express® Freight

To determine the rate for UPS Express Freight:

Step 1

Compute the billable weight (refer to page 12).

Step 2

Look up the shipping zone (refer to page 14).

Step 3

Calculate the rate:

- Use WorldShip® or the “Calculate Time and Cost” application on ups.com® to see the rate for your shipment.*

OR

- Follow the steps below to use the rate chart on the UPS Express Freight insert.
 - i. Go to the rate chart on the UPS Express Freight insert.
 - ii. Match the billable weight to the appropriate zone. Any fraction of a kilogram more than the weight shown in the rate chart is rounded up to the next half (0.5) kilogram.
 - iii. Additional charges may apply, including, but not limited to, special options or value-added services. Contact our Customer Service Representatives for more details.

* Rates provided through UPS's shipping systems are estimates only, and other shipping charges, surcharges or value-added service charges may apply based on your shipment characteristics and the characteristics of, and services requested for, shipments actually tendered to UPS.

Guaranteed door-to-door delivery for shipments greater than 70 kg to most major global metropolitan areas by 12:00 noon or end-of-day within one to three business days, depending on destination. Rates include customs clearance, pickup and delivery. Palletised and loose shipments accepted.
