How to determine billable weight

Compare the freight shipment’s minimum billable weight, actual weight and dimensional weight. The greater of the three is the billable weight and should be used to calculate the rate.

1. Minimum billable weight of a freight shipment is 71 kg.
2. Determine actual weight and round up any fraction of a kilogram to the next half (.5) kilogram.
3. Determine dimensional weight by multiplying the item’s length by the width by the height. For each dimension, measure the largest distance, rounding each measurement to the nearest whole number. The result is the cubic size. Divide the cubic size by 6000. Round up any fraction of a kilogram to the next half (.5) kilogram.

* Pallet billable weight is equal to the shipment weight (143 kg) plus the weight of a pallet (approximately 19 kg). Please note that each pallet and its secured contents is considered as one piece.

How to Determine the Transportation Charges

1. Compute the billable weight (refer to page 1).
2. Look up the shipping zone in the zone chart below.
3. Calculate the rate:

- Use WorldShip™ or the “Calculate Time and Cost” application on www.ups.com to see the rate for your shipment*

or:

- Follow the steps below to use the rate chart on page 3.
 - a. Go to the rate chart on page 3.
 - b. Match the billable weight to the appropriate zone. Any fraction of a kilogram over the weight shown in the rate chart is rounded up to the next whole kilogram.
 - c. Other charges, including, but not limited to, accessorial charges, surcharges and special or additional handling charges, customs duties and taxes applicable to the shipment or services requested may apply.
