



UPS[®] Worldwide Economy Capacity Surcharges

Due to recent market developments amid the ongoing Coronavirus outbreak, a Capacity Surcharge will apply to UPS Worldwide Economy shipments to the destinations set forth below, during the specified effective dates. Shipments will be rated with the Capacity Surcharge in effect at the time the shipments receive their first scan by UPS at the UPS Worldwide Economy export site. Capacity Surcharges will be applied as a rate per kilogram based upon the billable weight of the shipment.

The Capacity Surcharges listed below will be added to your current net rate for applicable UPS Worldwide Economy shipments. The Capacity Surcharges will be included in the transportation rate on your UPS invoice, rather than as a separate line item on the invoice. Capacity Surcharges apply in addition to all other applicable charges. No waiver, discount, or reduction of any type to the Capacity Surcharges shall apply unless UPS agrees in writing to such waiver, discount, or reduction with specific written reference to the Capacity Surcharges.
